



Planning Whole Class & Small Group Lessons

Lalilo can also be used to assist you with whole group or small group lessons. You can use the scope and sequence and the assignment feature to map out weeks or months of instruction.

Take a look at your pacing guide for phonics, word study and/or reading instruction, then compare it to our **Scope & Sequence**. You can use corresponding lessons in the Lalilo Scope & Sequence to support and supplement your literacy instruction.

Here are just a few ideas:

After you have taught a lesson, you can assign a corresponding Lalilo lesson to the whole class or a small group as independent practice.

Assign a lesson to your Lilo Demo account and work through it as a class or in a small group. If you are in person, you can use a projector or tablet and if you are teaching virtually, you can share your screen with students.

Assign a comprehension lesson to your Lilo Demo Account and work through it with the whole class or small group as a read aloud.

Assign a Lalilo lesson that corresponds to an upcoming whole group lesson to frontload or diagnose misconceptions before delivering instruction.
